Rhode Island Aviation Hall of Fame (RIAHOF) is a volunteer-driven non-profit group dedicated to identifying, honoring and perpetuating the memory of those individuals who have contributed to Rhode Island's rich aviation history.

Over the past twelve years we have inducted 66 individuals and one entire family (the Allen family of balloonists/aeronauts). We have also given special recognition awards to 29 individuals along with the four WWII WASP (Women Air Service Pilots) from RI, the 20 or so Tuskegee Airmen hailing from this state, and three National Guard units.

Few people know just how rich and varied our aviation history is, and just how many wonderfully skilled and talented contributors to the aerial age have been born in Rhode Island, were educated here, lived here for a portion of their lives or performed some great aviation-related act or service here.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SCOTTISH RITE HALL 1 Rhodes Place, Cranston. RI 02905

From Providence and points north:

Take I-95 South qnd/or Route 10 South. From Route 10, turn left at the last exit onto Park Avenue (RI 12). Continue 3.7 miles, crossing Rte. 1A/117 (Warwick Avenue). Turn right on Broad Street; continue one half mile, then turn right on Rhodes Place. The hall is the **building on your LEFT**.

From I-95, take Exit 16 for Route 10 toward Cranston and continue as above.

From points east:

Take I-195 to I-95 South and continue as above.

From Westerly and points south:

From I-95 North; take Exit 16 for Route 10 toward Cranston. Keep right at the fork, and follow signs for U.S. 1/Elmwood Avenue. Keep right at the next fork, follow signs for Elmwood Ave/Park Ave and merge onto US 1 S/Elmwood Ave. Then turn left on Park Avenue (RI 12), right on Broad and continue as above.

Ample on-site parking is available.
