DIRECTIONS TO THE SCOTTISH RITE HALL

From Providence and points north:

Take I-95 or Route 10 South. From Route 10, turn left at the last exit onto Park Avenue (RI 12). Continue 3.7 miles, crossing Rte. 1A/117 (Warwick Avenue). Turn right on Broad Street; the Center is one-half mile down on the right. From I-95, take Exit 16 for Route 10 toward Cranston. Continue as above.

From points east:

Take I-195 to I-95 and continue as above.

From Westerly and points south:

From I-95 North; take the exit toward Cranston. Keep right at the fork, and follow signs for U.S. 1/Elmwood Avenue. Keep right at the next fork, follow signs for Elmwood Ave/Park Ave and merge onto U.S. 1 S/Elmwood Ave. Then turn left on Park Avenue (RI 12) and continue as above.

Ample on-site parking is available.
